

### KEYS TO SUCCESS


YOUR TARGET.

RELEASE THE BALL BETWEEN YOUR KNEE & WAIST LEVEL.


FOLLOW THROUGH TO YOUR TARGET.

After teaching a hole layout, let your students DESIGN and CREATE their own hole...then play it.


ANALYZE their design and reconstruct as needed.

#### **Grants**

- 6. Projects must be approved by the Grant Committee.
- 7. Successful applicants may not apply for another two (2) fiscal years.


